TALK-ABOUT VIDEO - TALK-ABOUT ARMOR

After watching video discuss:

Show an umbrella. Say: **Remember how this umbrella protects us from water? It reminds me of something the Bible says about faith. The Bible tells us, “Put on God’s armor.” God’s armor is what protects us from evil, like the umbrella protected us from the water. One piece of God’s armor is the shield of faith. That means whenever we have faith, we have a shield that helps us fight God’s evil enemy. And we win because nothing can stand up against God’s armor! Let’s sing a song about that**

Lead kids in the following song and motions to the tune of “The Ants Go Marching.

We fight the evil one with faith! (*march with hands on hips*)

Hurrah! Hurrah! (*march and pump fist in air*)

We hold up our shields and stand real strong. (*hold out a pretend shield*)

And we all use faith to believe

God will...take care...of us.

Say: **When we believe God’s promises, we fight evil. That’s how we use our shields of faith—we remember God takes care of us and protects us from God’s evil enemy! We can fight God’s enemy with faith.**
